Guidelines

Requests must be based on the period of 1/1/2020 to 3/3/2021

Deadline to apply is 9/1/2022

Request must fit into one of the following four criteria from Ordinance 15 Council Bill 23 (2021)

- A. To respond to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (Covid-19) or its negative economic impacts, including assistance to households, small businesses, and nonprofits, or aid impacted industries such as tourism, travel, and hospitality;
- B. To respond to workers performing essential work during the Covid-19 public health emergency by providing premium pay to eligible workers of the metropolitan city, nonentitlement unit of local government, or county that are performing such essential work, or by providing grant to eligible employers that have eligible workers or who perform essential work;
- C. For the provision of government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue of such metropolitan city, nonentitlement unit of local government, or county due to the Covid-19 public health emergency relative to revenues collected in the most recent full fiscal year of the metropolitan city, nonentitlement unit of local government, or county prior to the emergency or;
- D. Make necessary investments in water, sewer, or broadband infrastructure.

Applications will go through the following process

1. Approval by finance committee
2. Ordinance introduced and passed by Common Council
3. Ordinance passed on second reading by Common Council
